## **Pavillon Once Again Earns Accreditation for its Programs**

**Mill Spring, NC – 2008.** The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities has once again accredited Pavillon for its detoxification, outpatient treatment, and residential Treatment programs. This latest accreditation is the second consecutive three-year accreditation that the international accrediting body has awarded to Pavillon International.

The accreditation decision represents the highest level of certification that can be awarded to an organization. It reflects the organization's substantial conformance to CARF standards. An organization receiving a three-year accreditation has completed a rigorous peer review process and has demonstrated to a team of surveyors during an on-site visit that its programs and services are of the highest quality, measurable and accountable.

Founded in 1966 as the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, and now known as CARF, the accrediting body establishes consumer-focused standards to help organizations measure and improve the quality of their programs and services.
