Formal group sessions are scheduled three nights a week with adjunct individual and family counseling scheduled at other times of the week.

The program further serves those patients who have completed an alcohol and drug treatment program and need additional support and therapy as part of their continuing care.

Eligibility is determined by a diagnosis of substance use disorder and the severity of the addiction, the ability to stay sober throughout the length of the program and a willingness to actively participate in the sessions.
